

Following the announcement by the Organiser to stop Rally Guanajuato México 2020 at the end of Section 5, the following procedures will apply:

1. The finish of the competition element of the rally will be TC 21B Parc Fermé IN where all cars shall remain until released by the Stewards.
2. There will be no Power Stage in this rally.
3. In application of WRC Art. 54.1.4, any crew which has retired from section 4 or 5 will not be classified and is released from all requirements under WRC Art. 55 (Repairs prior to a Restart), where applicable. The requirements for NACAM competitors pursuant to Art. 12.14 of the Supplementary Regulations remain, however, applicable.
4. Publication of the Provisional Classifications: 14th March 2020, 22:00hrs.
5. There will be a finish podium ceremony at Rally Campus for the winning FIA WRC2 and WRC3 Championship crews, for the Top Three crews in the overall classification and for a Representative of the winning manufacturer (without cars) at the Rock & Rally Arena at about 20:30hrs. Details on shuttles and the procedures will be communicated by the FIA Media Delegate to the teams concerned.
6. Cars selected for final scrutineering (notification at TC 21A) shall be brought to the location of final scrutineering from the Technical Zone between TC 21A and TC 21B, before checking in at TC 21B. The marshals' instructions must be observed. The co-drivers of the selected cars shall, however, mandatorily leave their time card at TC 21B. The car may be driven by a team member.
7. As agreed with the FIA Technical Delegate, tracking system devices and on-board cameras must be removed in the final parc fermé under the control of the marshals.
8. Post Event FIA Press Conference: 21:00hrs in the Media Center.
